



Data Protection and Retention Policy

Our Club respect your right to privacy. In this notice we explain how we collect your personal information, how we use it and how you can interact with us about it. Any personal information provided to or gathered by us is securely and confidentially controlled by the club.

1. The Purpose of Processing Personal Data:

Our Club processes personal information to administer and conduct Club/GAA/LGFA related activities. This includes membership and player registrations, team sheets, disciplinary processes, communications and notifications of Club events, club fundraising activities, coaching activities and compliance related requirements (i.e. vetting and insurance).

2. Storage and Retention Period for Data:

Your personal data will be stored in the Club and electronically on the GAA/LGFA Membership Database, which is provided by Servasport Ltd, 11th Floor, Causeway Tower, 9A James Street South, Belfast, BT2 8DN. Servasport Limited is a “data processor” who hosts the database on which your information is stored. The GAA/LGFA have a contract in place with Servasport Limited to ensure your Personal Data is stored safely and securely.

Your Personal Data will be held for no longer than is absolutely necessary, for the duration of your Membership and it will be deleted shortly thereafter in the event that you resign your Membership, or you are expelled in accordance with the GAA Official Guide. However, your Personal Data may be retained after your Membership ceases if it is decided that it is strictly necessary and proportionate to do so in the circumstances in accordance with our data retention policy.

3. Contacting Members

Member's data shall not be given to outside agencies or individuals at any time. All members shall agree to contact from the club in relation to general meetings of the club and club functions including matches and training. Members shall not be contacted by the club regarding other issues unless they have specifically agreed to this type of contact and an “opt in” option is offered.

4. The Right to Be Informed / Request your Personal Data:

You have the right to receive information relating to the processing of your personal data and this should be provided to you at the point your personal data is collected.

You have the right to request a copy of all of your Personal Data and can do so by contacting The Club. This information will be provided to you in a timely manner.

5. Privacy Rights in Relation to your Personal Data:

You also have the right to have your Personal Data updated, rectified, or deleted if you so wish. You have the right to object to your Personal Data being processed and to withdraw your consent to processing - You can do so by contacting Our Club.

6. Who Will have Access to Your Personal Data:

Your Personal Data can be accessed by certain members of the County Committees, Provincial Councils and the Central Council of the GAA/LGFA in connection with their administrative functions. This will be done in accordance with our data protection policy only.
